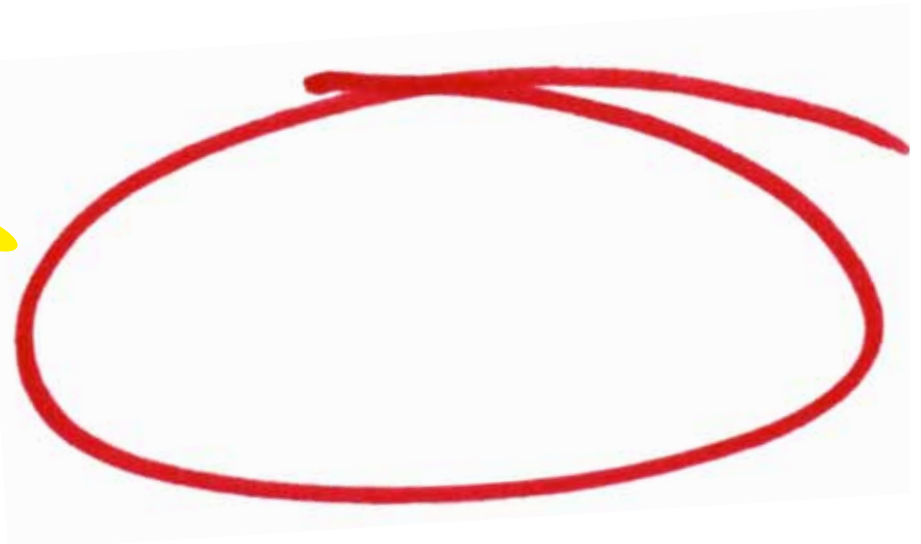

My Recipe for Slow Cooker Beef Stew

A hearty slow cooker meal perfect for those busy school nights!

PREP TIME 20 Mins. **COOK TIME** 12 Hrs. **READY IN** 12 Hrs. 20 Mins. **SERVINGS** 6

INGREDIENTS

- | | |
|--|---------------------------------|
| 2 pounds beef stew meat, cut into 1 inch cubes | 1 teaspoon paprika |
| 1/4 cup all-purpose flour | 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce |
| 1/2 teaspoon salt | 1 onion, chopped |
| 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper | 1 1/2 cups beef broth |
| 1 clove garlic, minced | 3 potatoes, diced |
| 1 bay leaf | 4 carrots, sliced |
| | 1 stalk celery, chopped |

DIRECTIONS

- Place meat in slow cooker. In a small bowl mix together the flour, salt, and pepper; pour over meat, and stir to coat meat with flour mixture. Stir in the garlic, bay leaf, paprika, Worcestershire sauce, onion, beef broth, potatoes, carrots, and celery.
- Cover, and cook on Low setting for 10 to 12 hours, or on High setting for 4 to 6 hours.
